Introduction

This policy describes DreamTrips International, B.V.'s ("**Company**" or "**We**") use of cookies on this website www.dreamtripsintl.com ("Website").

A cookie is a small file stored on the hard drive of your computer.

By consenting to our use of cookies, you are using the Websites in accordance with this Cookie Policy. This policy may change from time to time and your continued use of the Website is deemed to be acceptance of such changes, so please check the policy periodically for updates. Nevertheless, in case of substantial changes, such as adjunction of new purposes for the use of cookies, you will be asked to agree to the changes.

Cookies

We may obtain information about your general internet usage by using cookies. Use of cookies helps us to improve our Website and to deliver a better and more personalized service by enabling us to:

- Estimate our audience size and usage patterns.
- Store information about your preferences, allowing us to customize our Website according to your individual interests.
- Speed up your searches.
- Recognize you when you return to our Website.

Cookies are generally safe, as they only identify your computer. Accepting a cookie does not provide access to your computer or any personally identifiable information about you, other than the information you may choose to share. Other servers cannot read them, nor can they be used to deliver a virus.

Most browsers allow you to refuse to accept cookies by activating the appropriate browser settings. If you use different devices to access the Website, you will need to ensure that each browser on each device is adjusted to suit your cookie preferences. You can usually adjust browser settings to notify you of cookie placement, decline certain cookies, or block cookies completely.

However, if you select to block cookies completely you may be unable to access certain parts of our Website as We will not be able to use cookies that are essential for its performance.

Third Party Cookies

This and other Company websites may use third-party features to enhance user experience, for example embedded video from YouTube. When you visit a page that contains third party or embedded content, you may receive cookies from those websites. The Company does not control the placement or functionality of these cookies. More information about these cookies may be available on the relevant third party's website.

Some of our sites may make use of Google Analytics to help us track usage statistics about visitors to our websites. For information about how to opt out of being tracked by Google Analytics visit <http://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout>.

Web Beacons

Pages of the Website may contain electronic images known as web beacons (also referred to as single-pixel gifs) that permit the Company to count users who have visited those pages and for other related website statistics (for example, recording the popularity of certain website content and verifying system and server integrity). Web beacons are used to compile aggregated statistics concerning use of the Website. We also use pixel gifs in our emails so we can see whether and when emails have been opened and/or links them clicked on so we can understand better what content is interesting and popular with our users and what specific users interests are.

Disabling cookies

The effect of disabling cookies depends on which cookies you disable but, in general, the website may not operate properly if all cookies are switched off. If you only disable third party cookies, you will not be prevented from making purchases on our Website. If you disable all cookies, you will be unable to complete a purchase on our Website.

If you want to disable cookies on our site, you need to change your website browser settings to reject cookies. How you can do this will depend on the browser you use. Further details on how to disable cookies for the most popular browsers are set out below: -

For Microsoft Internet Explorer:

1. Choose the menu "tools" then "Internet Options"
2. Click on the "privacy" tab
3. Select the setting the appropriate setting

For Google Chrome:

1. Choose Settings> Advanced
2. Under "Privacy and security," click "Content settings".
3. Click "Cookies"

For Safari:

1. Choose Preferences > Privacy
2. Click on "Remove all Website Data"

For Mozilla firefox:

1. Choose the menu "tools" then "Options"
2. Click on the icon "privacy"
3. Find the menu "cookie" and select the relevant options

For Opera 6.0 and further:

1. Choose the menu Files"> "Preferences"
2. Privacy
